Community-Based Clinician / QMHP

A Village for One is a nonprofit organization based in Oregon City that provides outpatient and residential mental health and case management services to youth ages 12-25 who are at risk for or have a history of commercial sexual exploitation (CSEC). A Village for One serves Clackamas, Marion, and Washington County youth and has a contract with Oregon Youth Authority to provide services to incarcerated youth in Oak Creek Youth Correctional Facility in Albany, OR. There is intention to expand services to incarcerated youth in MacLaren Youth Correctional Facility in Woodburn, OR in the near future as well as have this position assist with other community-based client services in one or more of the counties A Village for One serves resulting in growth from part- to full-time.

Job Summaries:

- Provide individual, family, and group counseling to youth and young adults within the CSEC population.
- Conduct interviews with individuals to complete psychosocial mental health assessments and develop therapeutic treatment plans.
- Work as part of multidisciplinary teams with OYA, DHS, parole/probation, schools, and other community partners to provide holistic support to individuals served.
- Provide case management services to individuals as needed to assist in accessing vital basic needs and community resources upon transitioning into the community.

Schedule and Working Conditions:

- Part-time, (0.5 FTE, 20 hours/week) with hours flexible to meet the needs of the program and youth needs. **Potential to grow this role into a full-time (1 FTE, 40 hours/week) position through expanding services within Oregon Youth Authority facilities and assisting with services in A Village for One's community-based programming in Clackamas, Marion, and Washington Counties.**
- This position could require traveling in a personal vehicle to reach facilities and to transport community-based clients.
- This position requires commuting to Oregon City office headquarters on Mondays for team meetings and as needed.
- Sessions are held in the correctional facility but for youth transitioning into the community the sessions are held in the community setting, often meeting in client homes, coffee shops, and other public locations at are deemed safe and appropriate.

About You:

- Eligible for certification in the State of Oregon as Qualified Mental Health Provider (QMHP) or licensed clinical social worker, licensed clinical psychologist, licensed marriage and family therapist, or licensed professional counselor.
- Experience in a broad range of clinical interventions and mental health assessments specific to adolescents and families.
- Passionate about trauma-informed, person centered mental health services.
- Knowledge of the impact of complex trauma and sexual abuse, as well as experience working with disadvantaged and high-risk youth.

- Desire to provide empathetic and compassionate support.
- Enjoy working in a collaborative team environment.
- Must successfully pass required background checks prior to beginning employment, including a DMV Driving Record Check.
- Reliable transportation, no more than 3 traffic violations in the last 3 years, and up to date insurance required.
- Demonstrates effective communication skills and ability to provide culturally-competent treatment services to diverse client populations.
- 2-3 years of providing clinical interventions and assessments preferred.
- Pay differential available to bilingual Spanish and English speaking clinicians.
